### Dairy Goat Showmanship- Ribbons (Champion and Reserve Rosettes)

- Novice- 6 and under (as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>)- can be accompanied by an adult
- Junior- Age 7-11 years
- Intermediate- Age 12-16 years
- Senior- Age 17-21 years

# Dairy Junior Doe Division- (5 or more head must be present to show as a breed)

- Junior Kids- under 6 months of age
- Senior Kids- 6 months & under 12 months
- Junior Yearlings- 12 months & under 18 months
- Senior Yearling- 18 months & under 24 months
- Champion-Reserve Champion Junior Doe

# Dairy Senior Doe Division- (5 or more head must be present to show as a breed)

- The Senior Division consists of does 24 months of age or over that have ever freshened or are in milk. This includes dry milkers.
- Champion-Reserve Champion Senior Doe
